

1. The name of the school is Bridgemere CE Primary School
2. The school is a voluntary aided primary school
3. The name of the governing body is “The Governing Body of Bridgemere Church of England Primary School”
4. The governing body shall consist of:
  - a) 2 parent governors
  - b) 1 staff governor
  - c) 1 headteacher governor unless the Headteacher resigns the office of governor in accordance with Regulation 19.1 in which case the position shall remain vacant.
  - d) 1 LA governor
  - e) 8 foundation governors
  - f) 1 co-opted governor
5. Total number of governors will be 14
6. The Foundation Governors, other than the ex-officio Foundation Governor, shall be appointed by the Chester Diocesan Board of Education in consultation with the Parochial Parish Council of St John’s Church, Doddington and the Delves Foundation.

  - a. The holder of the following office shall be a Foundation Governor ex-officio: the principal officiating minister in the Parish of St John, Doddington
  - b. The Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry in which the school is situated shall be entitled to appoint a Foundation Governor to act in the place of the ex-officio Foundation Governor whose governorship derives from the office named in (a) above, in the event that the ex-officio Governor is unable or unwilling to act as a Foundation Governor, or has been removed from office.
  - c. The Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry in which the school is situated shall be entitled to request the removal of any ex-officio Foundation Governor and to appoint any substitute governor.
9. There is a trust for the school
10. Recognising its historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church at parish and diocese level. The school aims to serve its community by providing education of the highest quality within the context of Christian belief and practice. It encourages an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith and promotes Christian values through the experience it offers all its pupils.
