# Term: Spring

# English

In English, we will be using the texts 'Rosie Revere Engineer' and 'Grandad's Island' to help us to plan, write and edit our own invention and return narrative. We will also be looking at how we write explanation and information texts.

## Music

In Music we will be learning to sing in unison and play percussion instruments to create a particular mood as well as copy a 4 beat rhythm. We will begin to use graphic scores and dot notations.

# **Geography & History**

In Geography we will be getting to know our local town, Nantwich. We will be identifying human & physical features of local area using maps and aerial pictures. In History, we be investigating how shopping has changed in the last 100 years.

# Science

In Science, we will exploring materials examining different materials before classifying and grouping them. Later in the term, we will be identifying and observing plants describing how they grow.

# What a Difference a Century Makes!

This term, the children will be investigating how Nantwich has changed over the last 100 years. They will comparing pictures, maps and primary sources. We will also be considering how shopping has changed too!



#### P.E

In PE, we will begin the spring term by working with a dance specialist and completing our next unit of gymnastics before working on key fundamental skills in a range of games scenarios.

# **R.E/Spiritual and Moral**

In R.E we will be focusing on the Christian Community in spring term 1 and Resurrection in spring term 2. The children will be using the Bible to understand what make us a Christian.

#### Maths

Year 1 will be learning about: Numbers to 40, Properties of shapes as well as measurement.

Year 2 will a be learning about: Multiplication and Division of 2, 5 and 10, Length and Mass and Statistics.

## Art

In Art, we will be creating sculptures developing a wide range of art and design techniques using colour, texture, shape, form and space.

#### Design and Technology

In design and technology, we will be investigating, designing and creating a product. Children will be using a running stich and cross stitch to connect fabrics together.
