Term: Autumn

English

In English, we will be using the texts 'Old Bear' and 'Hermelin' to help us to plan, write and edit our own finding narrative and detective story. We will also be looking at how we write messages and letters to retell and inform others.

Music

In Music we will be learning to sing in unison whilst recognising different levels of pitch. We will sing songs linked to fairy tales as well as songs from around the world.

Geography & History

In Geography we will be navigating the school grounds using maps and aerial pictures using the four compass points before creating our own maps of the grounds.

In History, we be investigating the changes to our school grounds over the years.

Science

In Science, we will explore how we've changed so far and how we use our senses to navigate the world before investigating the weather and the seasons we experience in the UK.

Our School, Our Grounds!

This term, the children will be investigating how our school has changed over time comparing pictures, maps and primary sources. We will be considering what changes have occurred to both the human and physical features as well as mapping out the current school grounds using a key and symbols.



P.E

In PE, we will begin the autumn term by examining how our bodies change during exercise and gymnastics before working on key fundamental skills in a range of games.

Computing

In Computing, we will be learning about how to keep safe when using programs, how to search using a reliable search engine and beginning to investigate algorithms as sets of instructions.

Maths

Year 1 will be learning about: Numbers to 20, Position and Addition and subtraction

Year 2 will a be learning about: Numbers to 100, Multiplication and Division of 2, 5 and 10, Length and Mass.

Art

In Art, we will be using drawing, collage and mark-making to explore spirals within our sketchbooks.

Design and Technology

In design and technology, we will be investigating, designing and creating leavers and mechanisms to produce an interactive booklet for others to enjoy.
