**Overall aims of the committee are to;**

- Ensure that strategies are in place to raise achievement for all pupils and to monitor standards
- Ensure there is high quality teaching and learning across all year groups and monitor the quality of teaching and impact of professional development
- Ensure there is reliable assessment and high- quality tracking information for all learners
- Ensure the school's Christian distinctiveness underpins all aspects of school life and that the RE syllabus follows the Chester Diocese guidelines
- Ensure the school has a broad and balanced curriculum that satisfies statutory requirements and meets the pupils' needs including extension and enrichment activities
- Inform the board termly or more often as required regarding standards, the curriculum, teaching and learning recommend policies for approval.
- Present to the Resources committee any key financial and resource requirements to support the teaching and learning.
- Monitor the effective use of Pupil Premium and Sports funding
- Ensure that school's safeguarding policies, procedures and training are effective and comply with legislation

The Committee consists of a cross section of governors and the head teacher/CEO. A full committee meeting will be held at least once in each term.

Subject leaders will be invited to present to the committee meetings as required.

Quorum will be 3 governors who are members of the Committee
